

Trinity Bay Conservation District shall be responsible for operating and maintain the low pressure sanitary sewer system at your residence. The homeowner shall be financially responsible for repairs due to abuse of the unit.

Flush only toilet paper and human waste.

Abuse of the unit shall include but not limited to the following:

- bandages, wrappings
- cigarette butts
- cleaning agents
- coffee grounds
- condoms, contraceptives
- dental floss
- diapers, socks, rags or clothing
- disposable diapers
- dryer sheets
- ear swabs, cotton balls
- facial tissue
- fats, oil, grease
- feminine hygiene products (including applicators)
- flammable materials
- glass products
- hair
- inorganic materials
- medications
- metal
- paints, solvents, sealants, thinners
- paper towels
- pet waste, kitty litter
- petroleum products (oil, gas, etc.)
- plastic of any kind
- poisons, hazardous waste
- scrubbing pads
- syringes, needles, sharp items
- toys
- utensils
- wipes of any kind, flushable and non-flushable

Physical damage to the exterior of the grinder station basin, lid or control panel shall be repaired at the homeowner's expense.
