Cross-Connection Control and Prevention Policy

Trinity Bay Conservations District is always striving to improve the quality and safety of our water and our water system; in doing so we are required by the Texas on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to perform a Customer Service Inspection on all new homes including manufactured homes, remodels where the existing plumbing has been altered, new shops or barns that may have plumbing, new businesses or new industrial customers. To prevent interruption of your water service or penalties, we require you or your contractor to call our office to schedule an inspection **prior** to you moving into the home, occupying a building or before you receive continuous water service.

Cross-Connection Control and Prevention Policy = Resolution No. 18-09, Adopted September 27, 2018, Penalties: Criminal penalty—A person who violates a provision of this policy shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not less than \$300 and not more than \$1,500. Each day that one or more of this Policy is violated constitutes a separate offense.

This inspection is not a plumbing inspection; this inspection is limited to the identification and prevention of cross connections, potential contamination hazards and illegal lead materials. This inspection does not cost you anything and only takes a few minutes. We want to do our part to insure you are receiving the highest quality water we can supply to you and your family.
